

Facilitator Notes – New Heavens & New Earth (Shincheonji)

These notes support a facilitator leading discovery-based study. Let the Bible speak for itself.

1. Who is Jesus?

Aim: Show that Jesus is eternal and divine.

Key passages: John 1:1–3; Col 1:15–17; Heb 13:8.

Prompts: “Where was Jesus before creation? What titles does He have?”

2. The Promised Pastor Claim

Aim: Only Jesus is mediator.

Passages: 1 Tim 2:5; John 14:6; Gal 1:8–9.

Prompts: “How many mediators? Who does Jesus say He is?”

3. Exclusive Salvation

Aim: Salvation is through Jesus, not an organisation.

Passages: Romans 10:9–13; John 10:27–29.

Prompts: “What does a person need to be saved? Does the Bible mention a group?”

4. Secret Classes and Hidden Identity

Aim: Highlight openness and transparency.

Passages: Acts 17:11; 2 Cor 4:2.

Prompts: “How did the Bereans check teaching? What does Paul reject?”

5. Misusing Revelation

Aim: Revelation is for all believers.

Passages: Rev 1:3; 2 Pet 1:20–21.

Prompts: “Who is blessed when reading Revelation? Who explains prophecy?”

6. Claim: Jesus Returned Secretly

Aim: Contrast with clear, public return.

Passages: Matt 24:27; Acts 1:11; 1 Thess 4:16–17.

Prompts: “How visible/noisy is the return?”

7. Control and Isolation

Aim: Identify unhealthy leadership patterns.

Passages: Mark 10:42–45; 1 Pet 5:2–3.

Prompts: “How do true shepherds act?”

8. Extra Scriptures and Hidden Systems

Aim: Scripture is clear and sufficient.

Passages: 2 Tim 3:16–17; Psalm 119:130.

Prompts: “What does God's Word give to ordinary people?”

9. False Prophecies

Aim: Apply God's prophet test.

Passages: Deut 18:20–22; Jer 23:16; Matt 24:11.

Prompts: “What does God say when predictions fail?”

Summary:

Lead participants to the real Jesus who saves all who trust Him.
