Making Disciple Makers Diagnostic
Acts 2:36-47




Ask your disciple to read Acts 2:36-47 out loud.

Draw the parts of the diagram as indicated as they get to those elements in the verse.


³⁶ “So let everyone in Israel know for certain that God has made this Jesus, whom you crucified, ⁽¹⁾ 


to be both Lord and Messiah!” ⁽²⁾ 

³⁷ Peter’s words pierced their hearts, and they said to him and to the other apostles, “Brothers, **what should we do?**” ⁽³⁾ write this as the title above the diagram with Acts 2:36-47






³⁸ Peter replied, “Each of you must repent ⁽⁴⁾  of your sins and turn to God, and be baptized ⁽⁵⁾  in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins. Then you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. ⁽⁶⁾ 

While you encourage them to continue reading, circle those first few symbols, draw the 2 outer circles and the 8 segments


³⁹ This promise is to you, to your children, and to those far away—all who have been called by the Lord our God.” ⁽⁷⁾ Draw 5 small circles  down the bottom of the page


⁴⁰ Then Peter continued preaching for a long time, strongly urging all his listeners, “Save yourselves from this crooked generation!” ⁽⁸⁾ 

⁴¹ Those who believed what Peter said were baptized and added to the church that day—about 3,000 in all.

⁴² All the believers devoted themselves to the apostles’ teaching, ⁽⁹⁾  and to fellowship, ⁽¹⁰⁾  and to sharing in meals ⁽¹¹⁾  (including the Lord’s Supper), ⁽¹²⁾  and to prayer. ⁽¹³⁾ 

⁴³ A deep sense of awe came over them all, and the apostles performed many miraculous signs and wonders. *Skip an 8th - ⁽¹⁴⁾ **!!!**

⁴⁴ And all the believers met together in one place and shared everything they had. ⁴⁵ They sold their property and possessions and shared the money with those in need. ⁽¹⁵⁾ 

⁴⁶ They worshiped together at the Temple each day, met in homes for the Lord’s Supper, and shared their meals with great joy and generosity—
⁴⁷ all the while praising God ⁽¹⁶⁾  and enjoying the goodwill of all the people.

And each day the Lord added to their fellowship those who were being saved.” ⁽¹⁷⁾

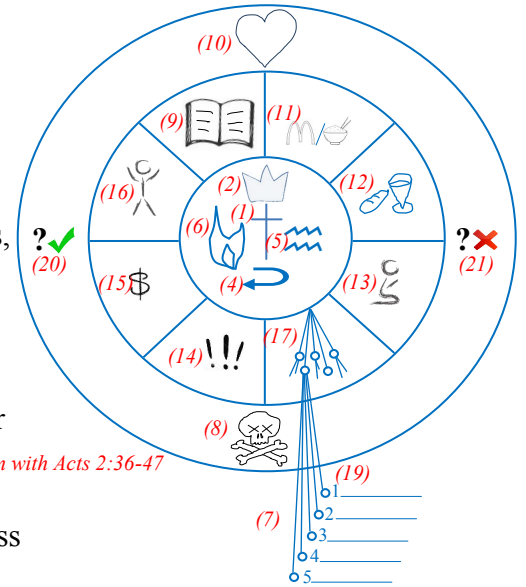


⁽¹⁸⁾ **Ask:** Who are 5 believers or new disciples, to start with, that you can share this with?

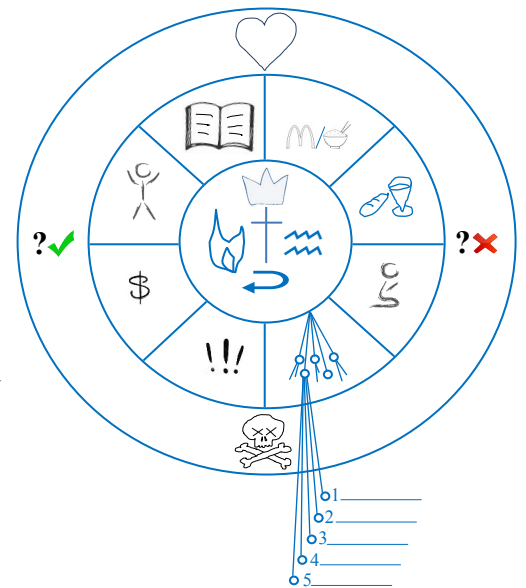
⁽¹⁹⁾ Draw lines reaching to those “far away” circles down the bottom of the page & write numbers 1 to 5 & lines for names next to them
